Dee Estuary SAC was classified as an SAC in August 2007 and was updated in December 2015. It covers an area of approximately 158km². Dee Estuary SPA and SAC overlap the same area.

SAC primary designated features: (1140) Mudflats and sandflats not covered by seawater at low tide; (1310) Salicornia and other annuals colonizing mud and sand; (1330) Atlantic salt meadows (*Glauco-Puccinellietalia maritimae*).

SAC secondary designated features: (1130) Estuaries; (1150) Coastal lagoons; (1210) Annual vegetation of drift lines; (1230) Vegetated sea cliffs of the Atlantic and Baltic Coasts; (1320) Spartina swards (*Spartinion maritimae*); (2110) Embryonic shifting dunes; (2120) Shifting dunes along the shoreline with *Ammophila arenaria* ("white dunes"); (2130) Fixed coastal dunes with herbaceous vegetation ("grey dunes"); (2190) Humid dune slacks; (4030) European dry heaths.

Designated species: Sea lamprey; River lamprey; Petalwort.

Management: Dee Estuary SAC is managed by Natural England and Natural Resource Wales.
