

Wyre-Lune MCZ



Wyre-Lune MCZ was designated in May 2019. It is an inshore site that covers an area of approximately 92km². The site is located in the southern part of Morecambe Bay, Lancashire, in the Irish Sea.

Designated features: Smelt. The main threats to smelt are considered to be barriers to migration and degraded habitat, rather than fishing activities. Therefore, no management has been put in place by NWIFCA.
